

Developed by expert painters and suppliers in Denmark, our plaster consists of premium, eco-friendly materials: Super-fine, crushed Dolomite stone is combined with recycled ash and natural pigments to create true, deep colour profiles and a durable finish that is beautifully soft to touch.

St. Leo's pre-mixed, coloured plasters are packaged in unique rectangular containers, ready to be applied onto interior walls with a roller and trowel, and finished with a trowel or brush to create a variety of elegant textures.

In addition to our core range, St. Leo works with clients and creatives to develop bespoke, site-specific solutions from an almost limitless spectrum.


Made from Nature




Perfectly Imperfect





An initial palette of 16 colours are mixed in Denmark to complement St. Leo's Dolomite Plaster collection in addition to an endless spectrum of tailored solutions made to order.


The Original Pigments collection features six products designed for use in domestic living spaces through to commercial spaces.

All products are mixed in all St. Leo colours allowing different performance needs to be achieved in a consistent colour palette.

At our Copenhagen studio we maintain full control of Original Pigments' core colour palette—designing and mixing each tone by hand to achieve the perfect result.



Finest Quality

Original Pigments is synonymous with Scandinavian quality and craftsmanship. Each paint is made in Sweden and Denmark from locally sourced ingredients and developed in collaboration with our local design community.

Original Pigments is crafted from the finest quality raw materials and formulated to achieve rich colour depiction, technical capability, safety, easy application and durability, whilst reducing impact on the natural environment. The product development process is results riven: each material is rigorously tested and selected for performance, then composed in unique recipes for gloss level, surface appearance and tactility.

Original Pigments uses the best quality clay and titanium dioxide—key compounds responsible for colour depth, coverage and texture—as well as a superior, waterborne and solvent free binder to provide strength and durability. Each recipe is thinned with water to achieve the desired paint consistency and low-VOC, healthy living environments.



Sustainability

Original Pigments, like Dolomite Plaster, is a sustainable collection crafted with the upmost care for the natural environment.

To produce the six finishes in the paint collection, we have selected suppliers who share our values, who are large enough to positively affect the industry as a whole with long term experience pushing the boundaries of sustainable ingredients and production, waste disposal, CO2 management and social responsibility.

Original Pigments represents many positive advances in the paint industry. The manufacturing process has a low CO2 footprint thanks to the use of local Scandinavian ingredients and suppliers, low transport use and ISO certified, low waste production. All products are waterborne, solvent-free, MI preservative free and low-VOC.

Since opening, The Audo has received interior design awards from *Bo Bedre*, European Property Awards and Ahead Awards.




